- a) Consideration to amend the City's current Fiscal Year Budget following Council's approval to:
 - (i) Add \$7, 912.00 to the Police Department's Capital Expenditure line-item 62-3211, transferred from the Court Fund Balance line-item 43-310, resulting in the total authorized expenditure of \$79,412.00 for the purchase of a new police vehicle by PD Chief Newsom.
 - (ii) Deduct expense funds from the Water and Sewer Budget line item 62-0223
 (Uniforms) in the amount of \$3,500, decreasing total line item to \$3,000.00 and reallocate the same to the General Operating Budget expense line item 63-333
 (PD Uniforms), increasing the total appropriated amount of said line item to \$7,900.00.
